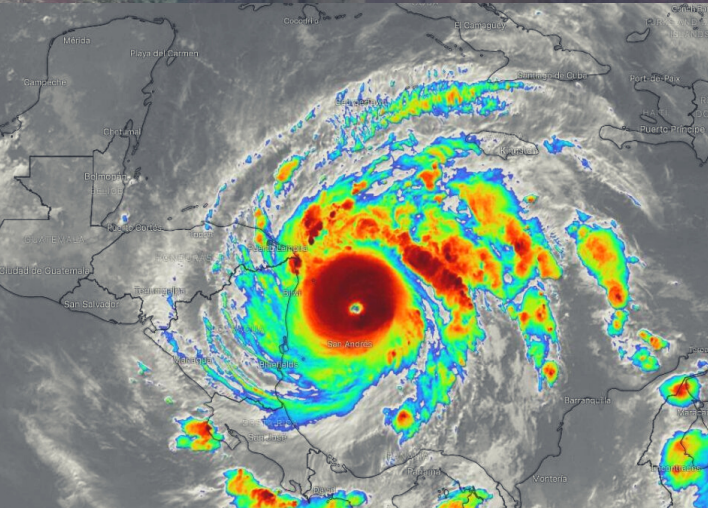

HURRICANE SEASON

As part of the rainy season in Nicaragua, two tropical storms in the Caribbean strengthened, becoming according to the Miami International Hurricane Center as Category 5, both Hurricanes Eta and Iota impacted on the Caribbean coast of Nicaragua, directly affecting the city of Bilwi, Puerto Cabezas, in addition to affecting the north of Nicaragua with heavy rains and winds.

As a protection strategy, the Aranjuez tutoring center was made available for shelter in case of emergency, 6 families part of our ministry were affected by the strong winds that resulted during the passage of Hurricane Iota.
